

NOTES REGARDING HARDWOOD

Whilst every effort is made to source well-seasoned timbers, it is inevitable that some wood movement will occur. All natural timbers, particularly hardwoods contain moisture. When this moisture level drops e.g. during long hot dry spells of weather or when the timber is subject to extremes in relative humidity you may find the timber will move very slightly or crack. This is absolutely normal & in many ways adds to the beauty of the product. To prevent your furniture from drying out over long periods of time the use of a small amount of beeswax is recommended periodically.
